Principal Update

Thanked everyone for giving time/energy in volunteer role. Reminded that everyone is here to support kids/school, and that everyone is on the same team. Presume positive intent, ask questions, and serve to support.

Expect changes due to changes in board. Presume that there are things people new to the board need to learn, and need support. Everyone coming to the table is welcome to offer ideas, but nobody on PTO (any position) can force someone else/PTO to take on tasks.

PTO is a separate, non-profit entity from the school. School can make requests but aren't the decision makers.

History: met this summer to get event dates on the calendar for critical dates. Last year when put to parent community to get PTO members there were no applicants. Niel and Erin offered to step up with the understanding there wasn't as much they could offer compared to past years due to time constraints, which was agreed on up front.

Teacher Liaison Announcements

Julie shared that staff are happy with the direction of the PTO, grateful for the support, very open to change/new ideas. The staff is understanding that most of board are full time working parents who can't devote 40 hours/week to the PTO. Teachers are open and willing to dial things back and be flexible.

Other News, Announcements & Topics to cover:

- PTO meeting time and format
 - Later time is harder for teacher attendance, but during day is harder for parents for pickup/drop off.
 - o Audianna requested later evening times to work better for some parents.
 - o Later time is impossible for board members.
 - o Idea of sending out a survey with multiple options. Add options that the majority of required board members could make.
 - o Finding coverage during the school day can be tricky for staff. Will need to get teacher coverage.
