



King Soopers Community Rewards Program makes it even easier to give back *without* spending additional money!

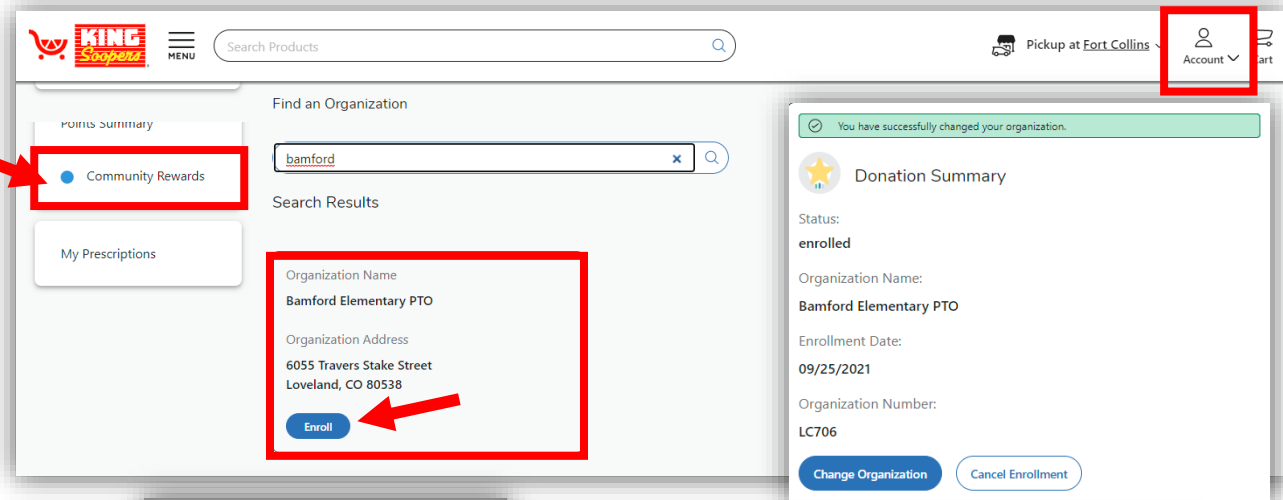

Enroll Bamford Elementary PTO under your Community Rewards & the school will immediately begin to earn a percentage of spending. See below for excluded items.

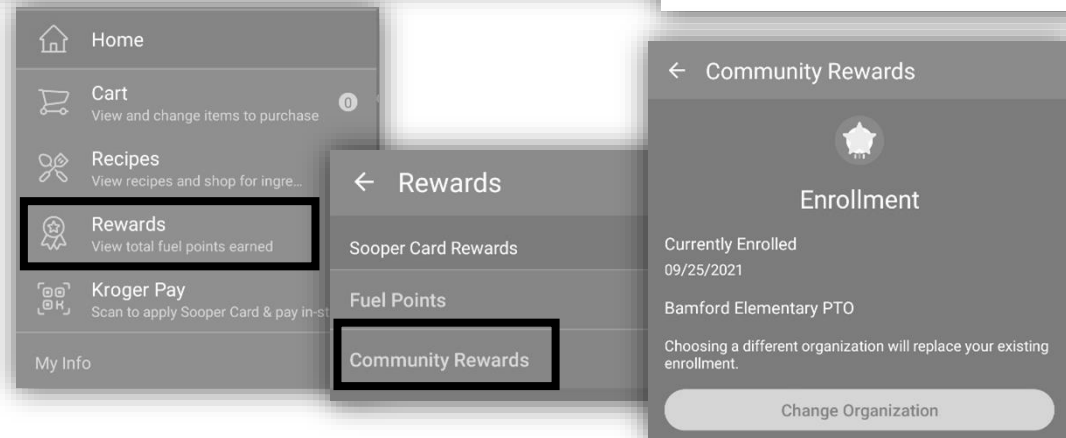
To begin, follow these directions online:

1. Go to <https://www.kingsoopers.com/>
2. Hover over "Sign In," (on the upper right) then click on "My Account" in the menu
3. Login with your current King Soopers account or create a new one! (can be linked to your current King Soopers rewards card)
4. Select "Community Rewards" from the menu on the left side of the screen.
5. Search for "Bamford Elementary PTO" and enroll the school as your organization!



You can also enroll from your King Soopers App:

1. Open the King Soopers app on your phone
2. Sign In if not already
3. Click the 3 lines in the upper left to access the menu and select "Rewards", then choose "Community Rewards"
4. Choose either Enroll or Change Organization
5. Search for "Bamford Elementary PTO" and enroll the school as your organization!



Supporters earn rewards on most items every time they shop. However, there are specific items that are not included: alcohol, tobacco products, government-assisted pharmacy expenses, postage stamps, Kroger Co. Family of Stores Gift Cards, Green Dot reloadable products, MoneyPaks, 1-2-3 Rewards Reloadable Visa Prepaid Debit Card, ReCharge Cards, American Express Variable Load Gift Cards, Visa Variable Load Gift Cards, MasterCard Variable Load Gift Cards, bottle deposits, lottery and promotional tickets, money orders, Western Union, fuel and sales tax are excluded from eligible purchases. Eligible pharmacy purchases include out-of-pocket co-pays for nongovernment assisted pharmacy programs.
